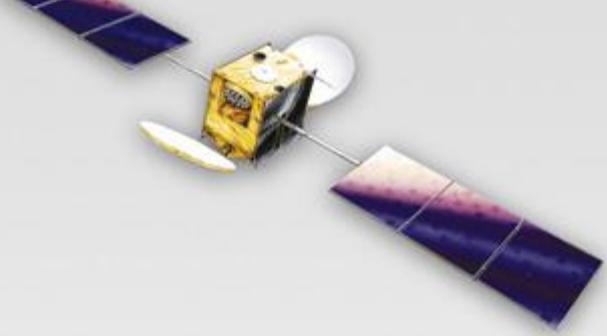
Here are your main responsibilities:

- Support the management of the Regulatory Audits findings and Compliance Monitoring:
 - Keep up-to-date compliance monitoring information
